

## CHURNING LETTERS

Follow the instructions **very carefully** to gradually discover the only reasonable explanation for Roger Woodward's historic experience in the Niagara River.

Print the word 'FALLS'

FALLS

Move the 3<sup>rd</sup> letter to the front of the word

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Change the last letter of the word to the letter that comes before it in the alphabet

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Place the 3<sup>rd</sup> vowel in the alphabet between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> letters

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Change the 2<sup>nd</sup> consonant from the left to the letter that comes before it in the alphabet

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Swap the positions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and last letters

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Place the 3<sup>rd</sup> letter of the alphabet immediately after the 2<sup>nd</sup> vowel

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Change the 1<sup>st</sup> letter to the letter that comes after it in the alphabet
